Early Monday morning



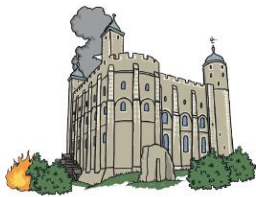
People carry their possessions to safety using boats on the River Thames.

Late Monday morning



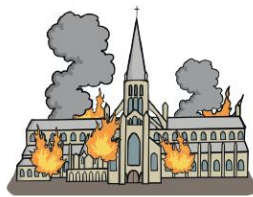
Carts are banned from going near the fire.

Monday evening



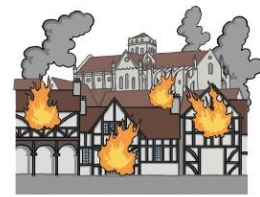
The fire spreads very close to the Tower of London.
